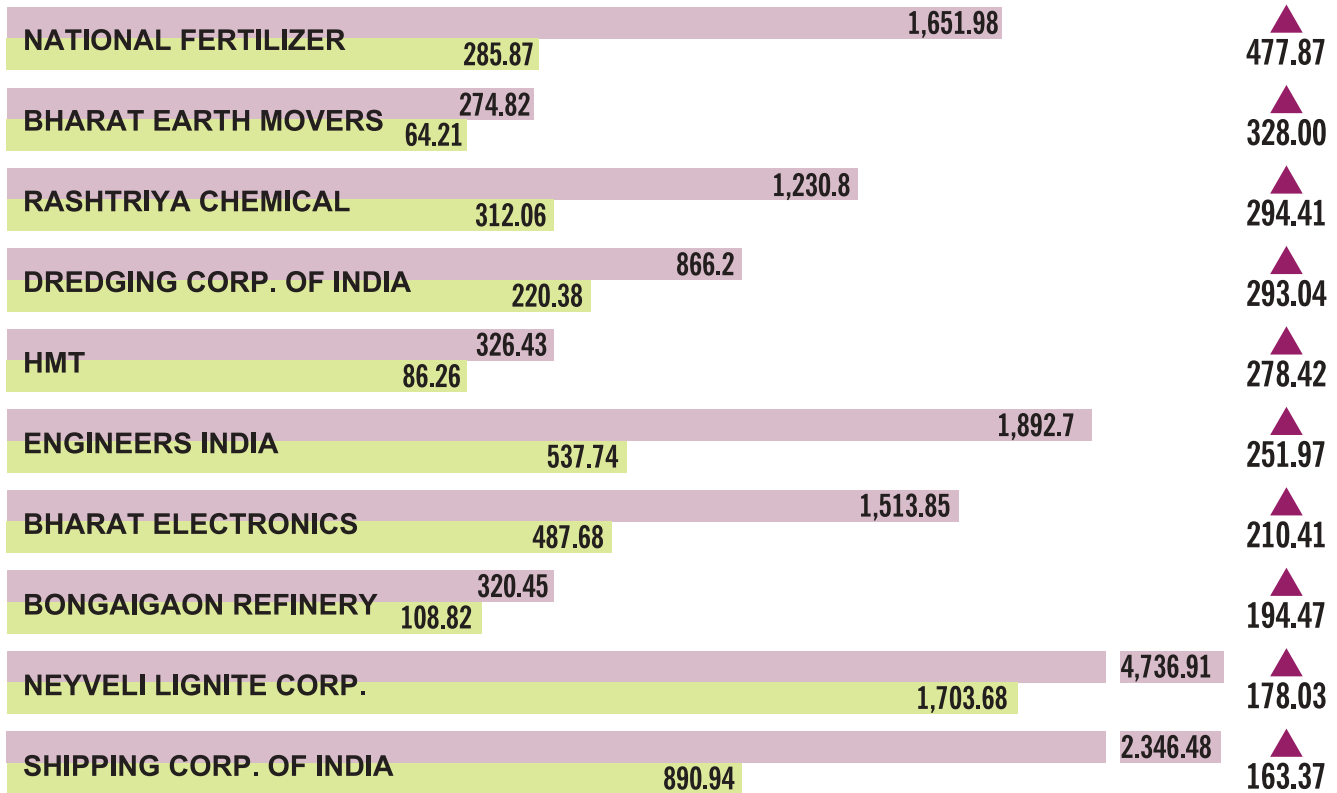
Top 10 Losers In Terms Of Ranking
